In 2023, MCBDD staff, Starlight students, and individuals served by the Board have set their dreams, believed and worked towards their goals, and achieved some amazing things!

Our Community Services department works to make sure individuals served have the opportunity to live, learn, work, and play in the community. Our Employment Navigation team helped to connect many individuals with employers, finishing the year with 97 people employed in the community, and many more on the path to employment.

FANS, People First, and the Young Adult Advocacy Group provide many opportunities for socialization, recreation, and advocacy. The Muskingum People First Chapter has several members who hold state-level offices in the People First Organization. Advocates attended conferences, where they participated in classes, networked with other advocates

from across the state, and gained confidence in their advocacy skills.

Early Intervention staff worked to make sure that children and families have the necessary resources and services to reach milestones and successes.

In 2023, Starlight School was recognized by the Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) State Support Team Region 12 as a Silver Award winner. Starlight was one of only five schools that received the Silver Award in all of Region 12.
